TOP TEN POINTS PROGRAM

Must be an MCCNE Member in good standing through-out the Show Season

MCCNE By-Laws: New Members are considered in Good Standing on the *first of the month following* receipt of application

A Points Program *Special Promotion* applies to the first show of the season – Points will be awarded to new members when application is received *before* the end of the month of the first show.

Car must be registered in a competitive class and be present at the show.
(Display/Corral registrations and “no-show preregistered” do not count)

Earning Points: For Peer Judged Shows
25 Points for registration in competitive class
25 Plus 5 Points = 30 Points for 3rd Place Trophy
25 Plus 10 Points = 35 Points for 2nd Place Trophy
25 Plus 15 Points = 40 Points for 1st Place Trophy
25 Plus 20 Points = 45 Points for Best of Division

Earning Points: For Judged Shows
25 Points for registration in competitive class
25 Plus 5 Points = Level Three Score
25 Plus 10 Points = Level Two Score
25 Plus 15 Points = Level One Score

Awards are made to the Top Ten point recipients at the MCCNE Awards Banquet
(Usually held in early March of the year following the show season).
In the event of ties, the top ten will be the top ten CARS

This illustrates a ranking of up to 7. If there were no ties, there would be 10 cars ranking 1 thru 10.

Top Prize: The Norm Miner Trophy

Number one ranked car(s) receives a plaque(s) signifying the top ranking and have their name(s) placed on the Norm Miner Trophy
Top Prize includes complimentary reservations for 2 at Awards Banquet

ENTHUSIAST AWARD PROGRAM

The Enthusiast Award is for Members in Good Standing that have participated in all the shows, even if not with a car entry, and contributed to MCCNE with participation in the show activities before, during and/or after the events. These are members who demonstrate “Enthusiasm” and support for the preservation of the Mustang. Club officers and directors are not eligible. An Executive Board committee makes the selection.
